## The More We Get Together

**Lessons:** Using the alternate G major fingering with middle, ring and pinkie to allow use of the index finger for melodic use.

If you're less into hanging out with others, maybe your rewrite focuses in on what makes you happy, or what happens to create misery for you when the group gets together.
